- **Support for Allied Health Professionals:** The IOS Allied Health Professionals Award is a grant that supports the professional development of IOS allied health members—such as APPs, nurses, and associate members by funding oncology certifications or attendance at national cancer-related meetings.
- **Community Impact:** The IOS Cares Program supports statewide cancer-related community initiatives and patient-focused projects.
